

2020 International Fee Schedule

Tuition Fees

Application Fee

An application fee of \$500 per student should accompany a new enrolment application to cover initial processing of the application.

Security Deposit

Upon confirmation of enrolment, a security deposit of \$2,000 per family applies. This is fully refundable when all students finish at the College.

Tuition Fees

A tuition fee applies to each Semester or part thereof that the student is enrolled. The fee is dependent on the year level.

Prep – Year 6	\$16,635 per year
Year 7 – Year 10	\$22,430 per year
Year 11 – Year 12	\$23,580 per year

Fees include textbooks, stationery, camps and other activities that are part of the normal school program, unless otherwise specified.

Additional Charges

The following charges are in addition to the Tuition Fees:

- Year 6 Canberra Trip \$750
- Year 7 Calculator \$27.50
- Year 11 & 12 Mathematical Methods Calculator \$242
- Extra-curricular Arts, Band, Music & Sport
- Optional excursions and events

Capital Levy

A capital levy of \$995 per annum is payable by each family as a contribution toward the College's building program.

Non-Tuition Fees

ESL Tuition

Tuition for English as a Second Language incurs an additional cost of \$4,120 per annum.

Overseas Student Health Cover

Upon request, the College can arrange overseas student health cover. This is approximately \$1,050 per student per annum.

QCAA Fees for Years 11 & 12

For International Students in Years 11 & 12, there is an additional fee levied by the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA). This amount is paid once per student, usually while the student is in Year 11, and is currently \$779.75.

Uniforms

Uniforms must be purchased from the College Shop or second hand from another family. The estimated cost per student for a full set of new uniforms is \$1,000. A price list is available upon request.

Bus Fares

A subscription to the College bus service is \$17 per week per student.

Payment of Fees

Due Dates for Payment

Fees and charges for each semester are due to be paid one week prior to the commencement of each Semester. Late payment may result in the student's enrolment being delayed.

In 2020, the due dates for payment are:

Semester 1 Monday 20 January 2020

Semester 2 Monday 13 July 2020

Payment Methods

The College will issue a statement of account at the beginning of each semester. Fees must be paid in Australian Dollars and may be paid via the following methods:

- Online by BPAY or Electronic Funds Transfer
- By EFTPOS or Cash at Campus Reception (Credit Cards accepted over the phone)

Please note that all fees are current for the Academic Year of 2020 only. Tuition and Non-Tuition Fees are reviewed each year by the College Board and may change from year to year.
